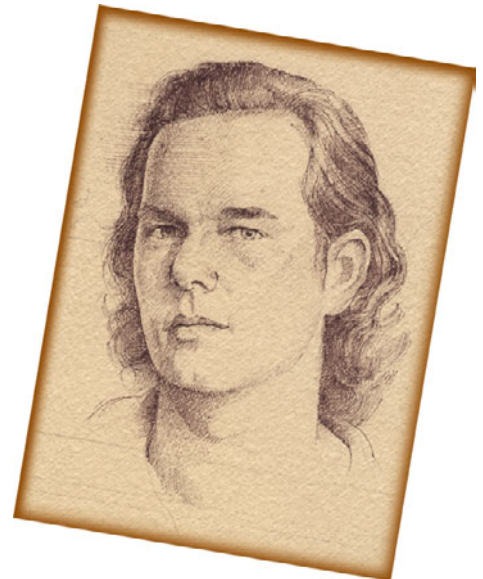
(Public Transport: take  Red Line to 94 or 96 bus.
